We donate the profit from the sale of merchandise, breakfasts and various events to help non-profit charities in Happy Jack, Flagstaff, Winslow, Payson and Santa Rosa, California. To date, the Starlighters have contributed over \$74,000 dollars!

Meetings and events are held monthly, February through December and have included lunches, shopping trips and tours.
