## **Approval of Prior Minutes**

 Motion made and seconded to approve last month's minutes as presented. Vote: Approved unanimously.

## Treasurer's Report

- Financial period: Two months into the fiscal year; no unusual variances reported.
- Annual compilation completed; state and federal tax returns prepared and to be filed by Aug 15.
- New CPA firm utilized; reduced cost and satisfactory performance.
- Additional CDs purchased to extend maturities and improve interest earnings on reserve funds.
- Assessments: Five outstanding; receivables actively managed.

## **Architectural Committee (Carol)**

- 32 active projects.
- Current activity: 12 new homes; 7 garages; 1 roof; 4 sheds; 3 decks; 3 fences/corrals; 1 exterior paint; 1 miscellaneous.
- July: 6 new projects; 10 projects completed.

#### Greenbelt

Don present; no additional report provided beyond business items below.

## Firewise / Education

- Ongoing Firewise inspections: lots 201 and up.
- Emphasis on compliance and ongoing maintenance due to very dry conditions and elevated fire risk.
- Inspection status update noted during discussion: approximately 99 passes; 101 fails pending re-inspection.

## **Property Rules**

- Board liaison (Wayne) absent; no standing committee currently exists.
- Public call for volunteers to form a Property Rules Committee to:
  - o Assist with inspections and provide recommendations (add/change/delete rules).
  - Ensure consistency and fairness in enforcement (e.g., fencing standards, including dog runs vs. garden fences).
  - O Support compliance checks at property transfer (architectural, property rules, Firewise) with notifications to escrow when needed prior to closing.

## Starlighters (Social Committee)

- Financials (as of Jul 30): Total income \$14,113.15; merchandise income from July breakfast: \$3.82.
- July breakfast served a record 127 meals.
- Upcoming:
  - o Highway cleanup Sep 12 with potluck after.
  - o Starlighters meeting to follow cleanup.
  - Aug 23 breakfast menu: cheesy green chili scrambled eggs, sausage links, hash browns, Danish, and fruit.
  - Labor Day (Aug 30): merchandise at Blue Ridge Fire Department; limited new items; sale at August breakfast.
- Public appreciation expressed to Lori Davis for ongoing support with reports and state tax filings.

#### **Member Comments**

- A homeowner raised a fine/violation notice; matter to be addressed in Executive Session.
- General acknowledgment: owners are responsible for guests' compliance with HOA rules (e.g., fires, greenbelt access).

#### **Community Business**

1. Greenbelt Motorized Vehicle Fine (New Standard)

- Background: Recent ATV use on greenbelt and cross-lot travel; current rules allow foot and horse traffic only.
- Discussion: Base rule violations typically \$50/mo until cured; some violations (e.g., open ground fire) at \$500.
- Member input: Suggestions ranged from \$50 to \$100; majority favored \$100 baseline.
- Motion passed:
  - o Driving a motorized vehicle on greenbelt (including e-bikes, ATVs, UTVs) carries a \$100 initial fine for a first infraction.
  - O The Board may increase fines in Executive Session for aggravating circumstances, and consider mitigation when appropriate.
- Reminder: Do not cross private property to access greenbelt.
- 2. Mailboxes/Parcel Lockers Proposal
  - Proposal scope discussed: additional parcel/mail units near compactor area; estimated cost approximately \$13,000 (parcel lockers noted at ~\$8,000).
  - Considerations: Changing status of Long Valley/Happy Jack postal options; Amazon's rural delivery expansion; USPS half-mile delivery constraints; underutilized mailboxes; potential cost recovery and long-term plan for all lots.
  - Decision: Defer expenditure; monitor developments (Amazon delivery changes, USPS/PO status) over the next 6-12 months before committing funds.
- 3. Insurance Renewals D&O and Crime
  - Directors & Officers premium increased 9.9%; Crime policy flat year-over-year; within budget/expectations.
  - Motion to accept bids. Vote: Approved unanimously.
  - Note: Property and Workers Comp renewals to follow per schedule.
- 4. Income Tax Resolution
  - No action this month.
- 5. Letter of Engagement Accounting Services (Lori)
  - Formalizing annual engagement for bookkeeping and tax services; no management functions included.
  - Motion to approve engagement letter.

Vote: Approved unanimously.

- 6. AmeriGas Community Agreement
  - Fixed community price: \$1.711/gal (Sept 1, 2025–Sept 30, 2026).
  - Comparative note: Ferrellgas offering \$1.729 for the rest of the summer.
  - Agreement enables members to access AmeriGas at stated price; members' ability to choose providers depends on tank ownership/lease status.
  - Motion to approve AmeriGas agreement. Vote: Approved unanimously.
